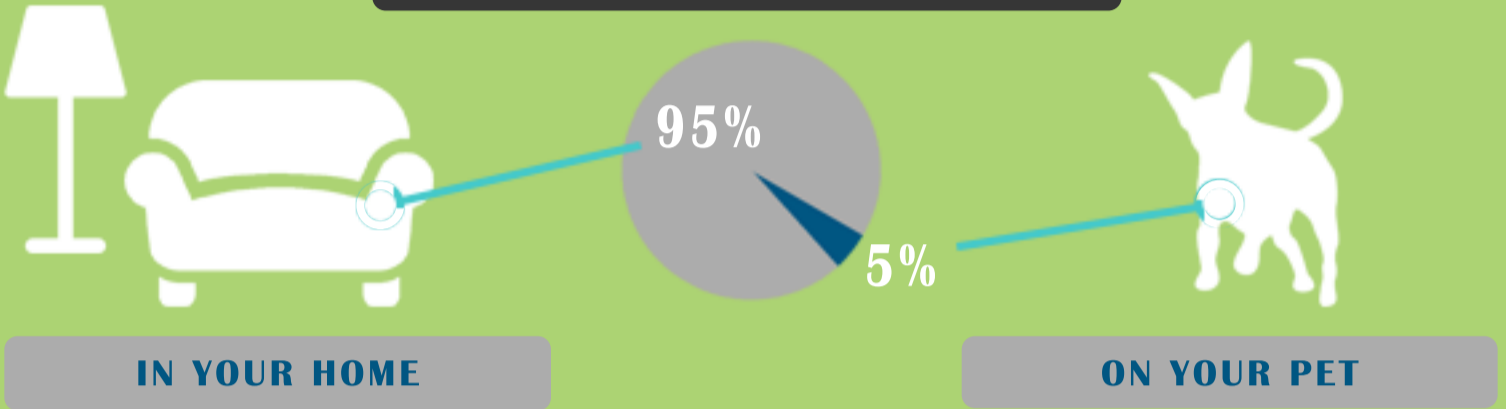


HOW TO ATTACK A FLEA INFESTATION

STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

WHERE ARE THE FLEAS?



IT'S GOING TO TAKE TIME

A flea infestation can last 10 days to 2 months.



TREAT YOUR PETS

Visit your veterinarian - they will usually administer a Capstar pill, which will begin killing adult fleas within 10-30 minutes.

All pets in the household need to be treated - whether or not they currently have fleas.

GET MEAN ON CLEAN



SWEEP

- ▶ Tile Floors
- ▶ Wood Floors
- ▶ Then mop thoroughly



VACUUM

- ▶ Carpet
- ▶ Upholstered furniture
- ▶ Pillows
- ▶ Mattresses



TRASH

- ▶ Vacuum bags
- If you don't properly dispose, eggs can hatch and reinfest your home*



WASH

- ▶ Rugs
- ▶ Bedding
- ▶ Toys
- ▶ Curtains



FOG

- ▶ Spot & crevice spray
- ▶ Carpet & upholstery spray
- ▶ Household fogger



YARD

- ▶ Remove low-hanging branches & brush
- ▶ Residual insecticide

BRING IN THE PROFESSIONALS

Getting rid of fleas is time consuming and not always 100% effective. For heavy flea infestations you will want to consult an exterminator - for your home and your yard. It's their job to eliminate pests and they have lots of practice doing it.



PREVENTION IS BEST
